Art Graphics

Course description

This is a specialised course that considers all aspects of graphic design through exploring a range of graphics media and techniques.

Students will be required to work in a variety of areas, exploring and showing understanding of hand rendered and computer graphics, illustration, advertising, packaging design, branding and typography.

Students will need to be keen to learn new skills as well as developing and improving existing skills in art and design. Students will need to be able to draw, paint and show analytical understanding of artists and graphic designers.

Students must realise the importance of pride in the presentation of their work, and they will be marked on this throughout the course. Students will be expected to work on their coursework independently outside of lesson time and they will be expected to attend a catch up session once a week after school.
