Through GCSE Drama you will develop the essential skills of working collaboratively and cohesively in teams, public speaking and presentation, resilience, empathy and creativity.

There will be opportunities to see a variety of live theatre at different venues during the course.

Assessment

Devising plays (40%) - Creating and devising your own piece of Drama in groups, based on a stimuli. You will be assessed on:

- A final devised TIE performance
- An audio/visual portfolio of your process
- A written evaluation.

Performance from a text (20%) - A group, scripted performance of two sections of a play for an external examiner. You will be assessed on:

- Your final acting performance only.

Interpreting Theatre (40%) - 90 minute written exam

You will be assessed on your answers to:

- A series of short and extended questions on a set text studied
- Your response to a live production seen during the course.
