Level 3 Courses - Two Year Advanced Programme

Students entering Year 12 are expected to study three subjects, please select **one subject from each option block**. In addition, all students follow a PSHEE Programme.

Level 2 Courses - One Year Programme

If you are not eligible to apply for the Level 3 courses, you may wish to apply to join a Level 2 Course. Students normally require a minimum of 5 GCSEs at Grades 9-2, including Mathematics, English Language at Grade 3. Following completion of this course there is no automatic route into HBHS Level 3 courses. Most students normally progress onto a vocational route.
