### Summer 2021 - GCSE and A Level results

I hope you are all well and managing to stay healthy and safe in these challenging times.

I am writing to inform you of the process we are putting in place for the distribution of Year 11 and Year 13 examination results in the summer which unfortunately is going to be different to our normal practice due to the impact of the pandemic.

The two results days this year are as follows:

- Year 13 A Level: Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> August 2021
- Year 11 GCSE: Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> August 2021

On the relevant results day, the school will e-mail **students** their 'Candidate Statement of Results, a covering letter and any other supporting information directly to the **student school email account**. The e-mail will be sent after 9.00am on the relevant day, which is similar timing to when we would have handed them out in person. A printed copy of the results will be posted out later on each results day.

We will have a similar remote support mechanism to last year, which worked fantastically. On both results days there will be staff available to talk through next steps, destinations and guidance should it be required. This will all be included in the letter that comes out with the results.

Please also be aware that the results your child receives are grades that are awarded by the examination boards based on the data and information that the school provided to them in June. As such we have no direct sight of the grades until they are published. Candidate results will be reported on results days and appear on certificates as final grades, either as a letter or number depending on the qualification. There will not be any unit, component, or paper-level marks because no public exam papers were taken.
